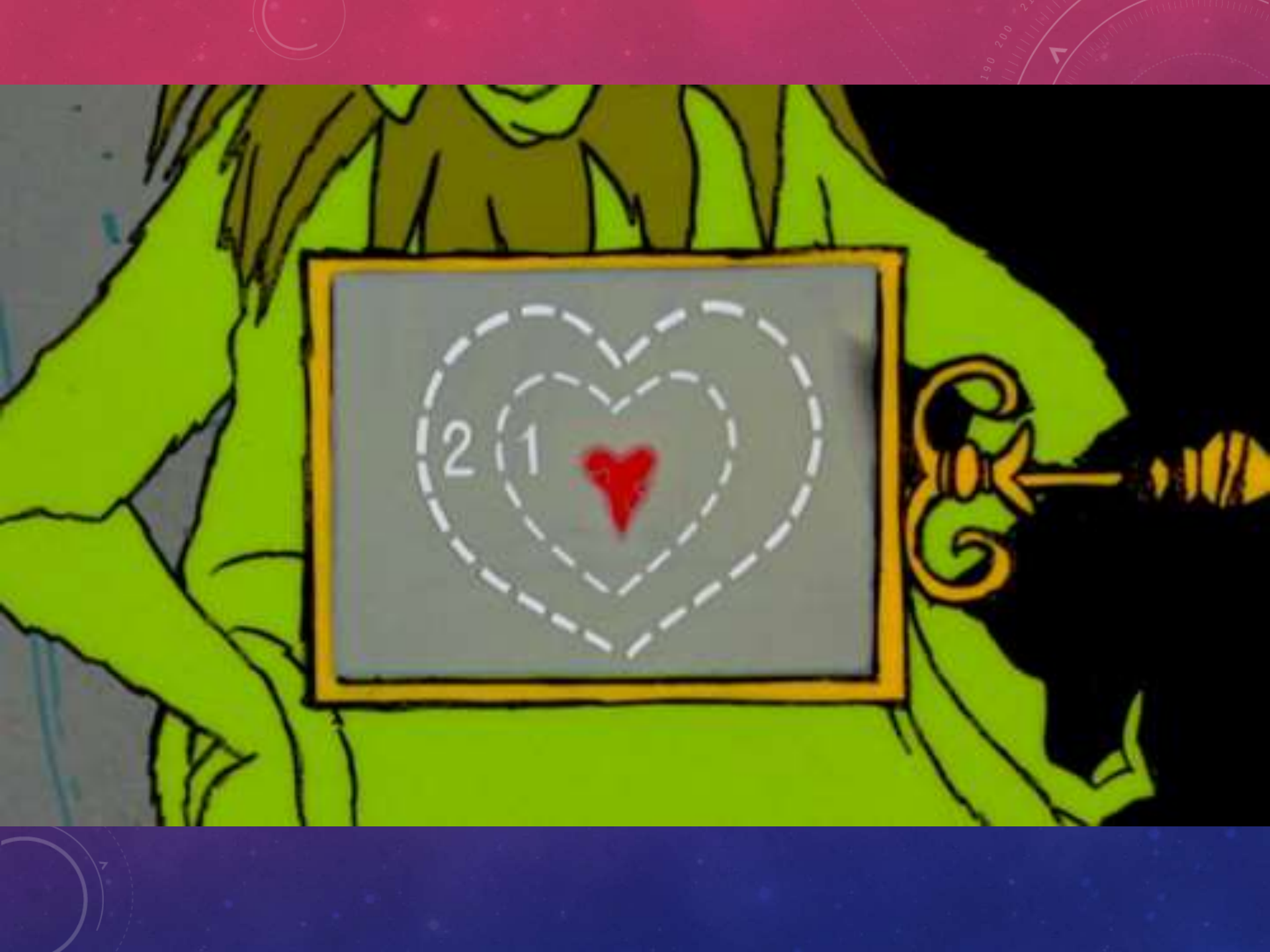

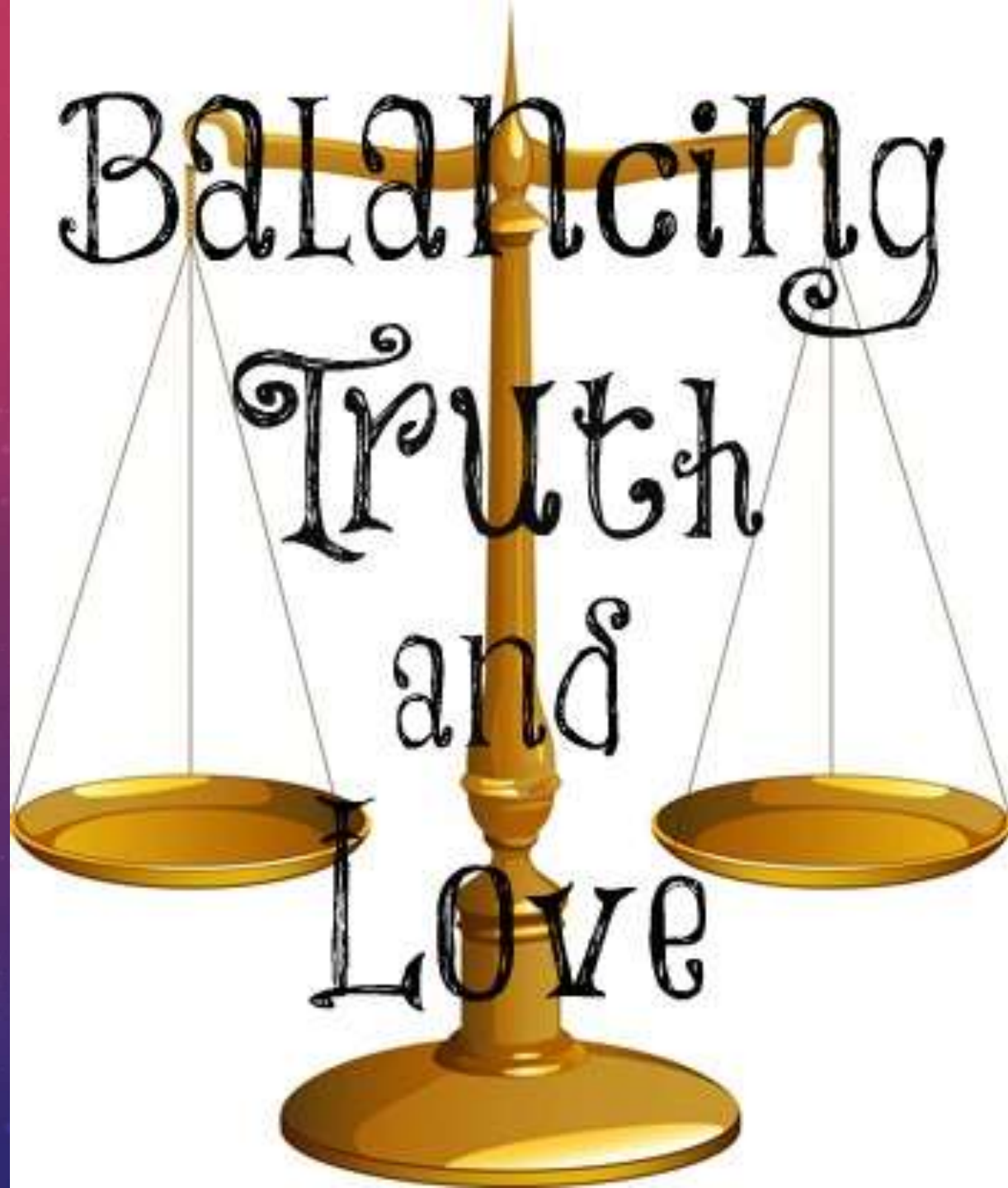
Now John answered Him, saying,

but rejoices in the truth.



Disciple whom Jesus Loved



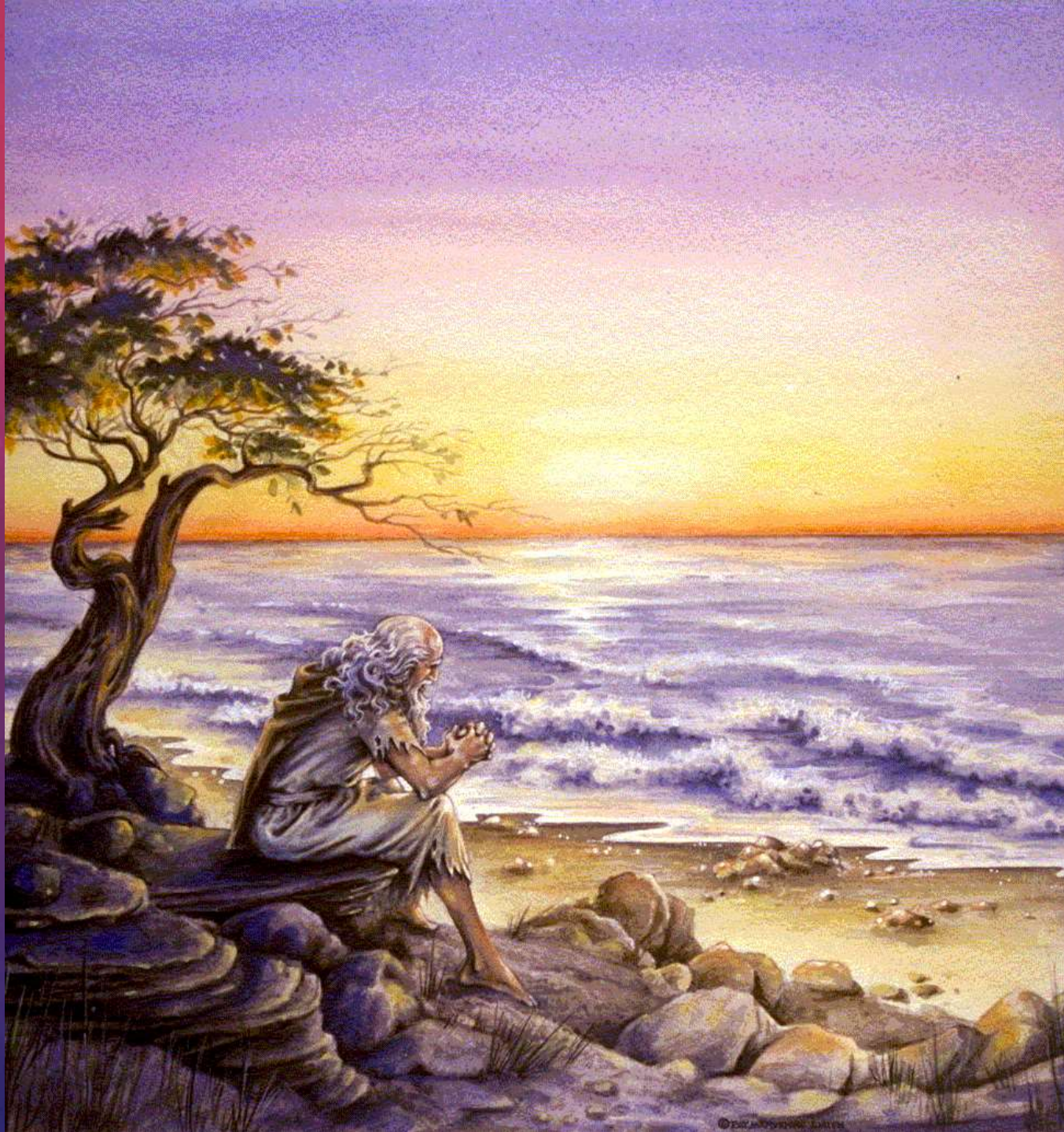
Drink the cup that I
