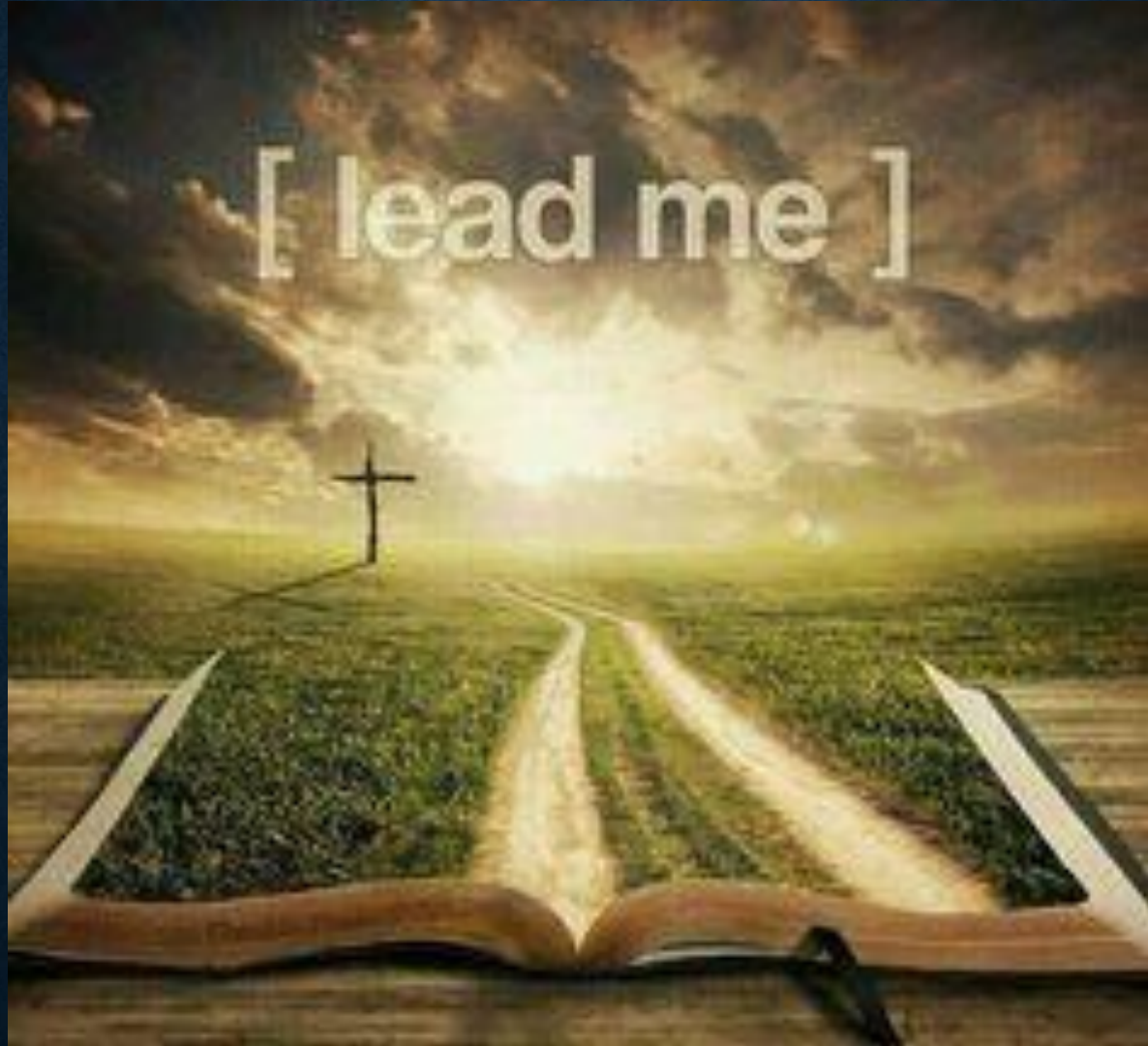


# **JUDAS THE TRAITOR**

# JOHN 12:4-5

**Then one of His disciples, Judas  
Iscaiot, Simon's son, who would betray  
Him, said, "Why was this fragrant oil  
not sold for 300 denarii and given to the  
poor?"**

# **JOHN 12:6**

**This he said, not that he cared for the poor, but because he was a thief, and had the money box; and he used to take what was put in it.**



# **MATTHEW 26:14-16**

**Then one of the 12, called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests and said, “What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?” And they counted out to him 30 pieces of silver. So from that time he sought opportunity to betray Him.**

# JOHN 13:8-9

**8 “If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me,” 9 Peter replied, “Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head!”**

# JOHN 13:10

**“He who is bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean, and you are clean, but not all of you.”**

will betray Me.”**



# JOHN 13:23-30

<sup>23</sup> One of his disciples, whom Jesus loved, was reclining at table at Jesus' side, <sup>24</sup> so Simon Peter motioned to him to ask Jesus of whom he was speaking. <sup>25</sup> So that disciple, leaning back against Jesus, said to him, "Lord, who is it?"

# JOHN 13:23-30

<sup>26</sup> Jesus answered, “It is he to whom I will give this morsel of bread when I have dipped it.” So when he had dipped the morsel, he gave it to Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot.

# JOHN 13:23-30

**<sup>27</sup> Then after he had taken the morsel, Satan entered into him. Jesus said to him, “What you are going to do, do quickly.” <sup>28</sup> Now no one at the table knew why he said this to him.**



# JOHN 13:23-30

**<sup>29</sup> Some thought that, because Judas had the moneybag, Jesus was telling him, “Buy what we need for the feast,” or that he should give something to the poor. <sup>30</sup> So, after receiving the morsel of bread, he immediately went out. And it was night.**

# **JOHN 18:3**

**Then Judas, having received a detachment of troops, and officers from the chief priests and Pharisees, came there with lanterns, torches, and weapons.**

# **JOHN 18:4-5**

# **LUKE 22:48**

**Jesus said to him, “Judas, are you  
betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?”**

# **MATTHEW 27:3-4**

**3 Then Judas, His betrayer, seeing that He had been condemned, was remorseful and brought back the 30 pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, 4 saying, “I have sinned by betraying innocent blood.” They said, “What is that to us? You see to it!”**

# **MATTHEW 27:5**

**Then he threw down the pieces of silver in the temple and departed, and went and hanged himself.**



# **MATTHEW 27:6-8**

**6 But the chief priests took the silver pieces and said, “It is not lawful to put them into the treasury, because they are the price of blood.”**

**7 And they consulted together and bought with them the potter’s field, to bury strangers in. 8 Therefore that field has been called the Field of Blood to this day.**

# **ACTS 1:18-19**

**18 This man purchased a field with the wages of iniquity; and falling headlong, he burst open in the middle and all his entrails gushed out.**

**19 And it became known to all those dwelling in Jerusalem; so that field is called in their own language, Akel Dama, that is, Field of Blood.”**
