Healthy Fears

❖ Fear of the Lord

- ❖ ²⁶ Whoever fears the LORD has a secure fortress,
and for their children it will be a refuge.

Shying Away From Opportunities to Share our Faith

► Faith of the Centurion

- ▶ ⁵⁵ And when some there had kindled a fire in the middle of the courtyard and had sat down together, Peter sat down with them.
⁵⁶ A servant girl saw him seated there in the firelight. She looked closely at him and said, "This man was with him."
- ▶ ⁵⁷ But he denied it. "Woman, I don't know him," he said
- ▶ ⁵⁸ A little later someone else saw him and said, "You also are one of them."

- ▶ ¹⁰ Moses said to the LORD, “Pardon your servant, Lord. I have never been eloquent, neither in the past nor since you have spoken to your servant. I am slow of speech and tongue.”

- ▶ ¹³ "Lord," Ananias answered, "I have heard many reports about this man and all the harm he has done to your holy people in Jerusalem. ¹⁴ And he has come here with authority from the chief priests to arrest all who call on your name."

- ▶ ³⁴ But David said to Saul, “Your servant has been keeping his father’s sheep. When a lion or a bear came and carried off a sheep from the flock, ³⁵ I went after it, struck it and rescued the sheep from its mouth.
- ▶ When it turned on me, I seized it by its hair, struck it and killed it. ³⁶ Your servant has killed both the lion and the bear; this uncircumcised Philistine will be like one of them, because he has defied the armies of the living God. ³⁷ The LORD who rescued me from the paw of the lion and the paw of the bear will rescue me from the hand of this Philistine.” 1Samuel 17:32–37
