JAMES 1:12-16

James 1:12-16

- ▶ Jas 1:12 <u>Blessed is the man that endures temptation</u>: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord has promised to them that love him.
- ▶ Jas 1:13 Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for <u>God cannot be tempted with evil,</u> neither does He tempt any man:
- ▶ Jas 1:14 But every man is tempted, when he is <u>drawn</u> <u>away of his own lust, and enticed</u>.
- ▶ Jas 1:15 Then when <u>lust has conceived</u>, it <u>brings forth sin</u>: and sin, <u>when it is finished</u>, brings forth <u>death</u>.
- ▶ Jas 1:16 Do not err, my beloved brethren.

Key Questions

Tempted of Who?

- ▶ Jas 1:13 Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither He tempts any man:
- God tempts no one!
 - ▶ He may allow your faith to be tested.
 - ► He may allow you to be presented with circumstances where there is a choice between good and evil.
 - God places nothing before any human being with a view to induce him to do wrong. Many have attributed their failures to God and not taken responsibility upon themselves. This is a grave mistake!
- ▶ Jas 1:14 But every man is tempted, when he is <u>drawn</u> away of his own lust, and enticed.

Pathway to Sin

- ▶ 2Ti 4:3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;
- 2Pe 3:3 Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts,
- ▶ Jud 1:18 How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts.

The Solution

- ▶ 1Co 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. <u>God is faithful</u>, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the <u>way of escape</u>, that you may be able to endure it. Also see Jude 1:20ff
- We will be tempted our entire lives! Expect it! Be diligent!
- How we handle temptation is a <u>matter of the truth of our</u> <u>hearts towards God!</u>
- Endure temptation to be approved of God! Get the crown of life!!
