

Regret


Regret – μετανιώνω - metanióno

Most Common Regrets

- Living A Life of Moral Abandon
- Relationships
- Expressing Feelings
- Untimely Action or Inaction
- Wasted Time
 - Worry
 - About someone else
 - About something else



Lessons of Regret in Scripture

- Many throughout the OT (Jews regret of disobedience)
- The Rich Man & Lazarus (Lk. 16:19-31)
- Paul's Persecution of the Church (Act. 8:3; 26:10-11, Gal. 1:13)
- Peter vs Judas (Lk. 22:61 vs Mat. 27:3-5)
- Others...

Godly Sorrow = No Regrets



- God approves of grief leading to Repentance
- 1Co 3:14-15 If the work that anyone has built on the foundation survives, he will receive a reward. (15) If anyone's work is burned up, he will suffer loss, though he himself will be saved, but only as through fire.
- 2Co 7:10 For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret, whereas worldly grief produces death.

- Php 3:13 Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, (14) I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.
