"Bless Your Heart"

- A common phrase in the Southern United States with multiple meanings.
- A sincere expression of sympathy or genuine concern.
- A precursor to soften the blow of an insult.
 - "You are dumb as a rock, but you can't help it, Bless Your Heart.
 - A way to "be kind and sweet" and not "act ugly."

More Than "Bless Your Heart"

In the 1 century, kindness not only mellowed anything that was harsh, it actively treated others with fairness and justice.

Thus, kindness was closely connected to actively pursuing goodness, generosity, gentleness, and usefulness.

The Kindness of God in the Old Testament

- Pervades every aspect of his character and not compromising any of the other aspects of his nature.
- God can call his people to accountability, rebuke them for their sinfulness and at stil exude kindness.
- This can be seen in the book of the Psalms, and the Prophets.
- Hosea, in particular demonstrates God's kindness can coexist with his justice and discipline.

"When Israel was a child, I loved him, and out of Egypt I called my son. But the more they were called, the more they went away from me. They sacrificed to the Baals and they burned incense to images.

It was I who taught Ephraim to walk, taking them by the arms; but they did not realize it was I who healed them. I led them with cords of human kindness, with ties of love.

The Kindness of God in the **New Testament**

"Love your enemies! Do good to them. Lend to them without expecting to be repaid. Then your reward from heaven will be very great, and you will truly be acting as children of the Most High, for he is kind to those who are unthankful and wicked. You must be compassionate, just as your Father is compassionate.

The Kindness of God is Transformational
