






Galatians 5:22-26








1 John 3:16-18










"If anyone wants to sue you, and take your shirt, hand over your coat as well. And if anyone forces you to go one mile, go with them two miles"




Colossians 3:12-14




"Do you think lightly of the riches of his kindness and forbearance and patience, not knowing that the kindness of God leads you to repentance?"




Matthew 11:28-30




