


What the Cross Does...

What God Did For the Cross, He Can Do for You It's not that God used the cross in spite of its weakness - he chose the cross **because** of its weakness.




What God Did For the Cross, He Can Do for You "Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me."


