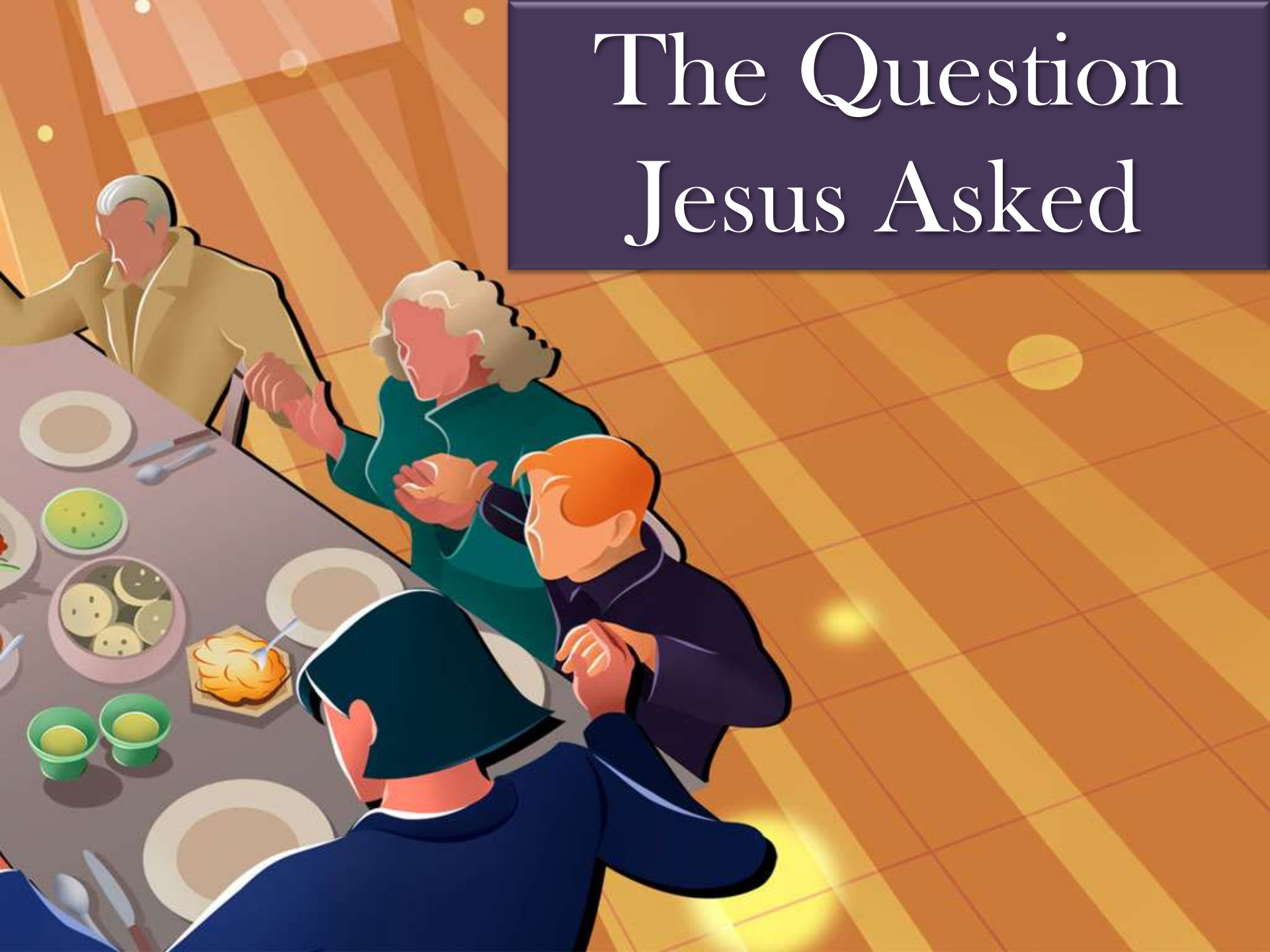


Because of his great love for us, God,

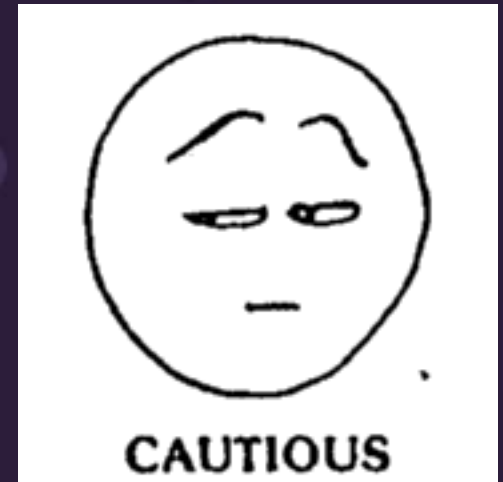
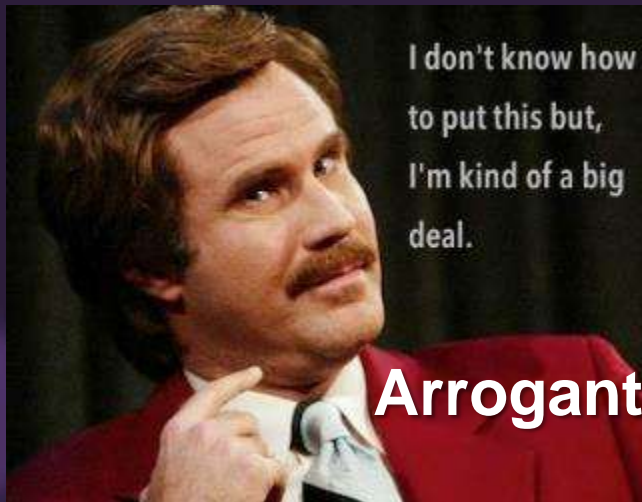
