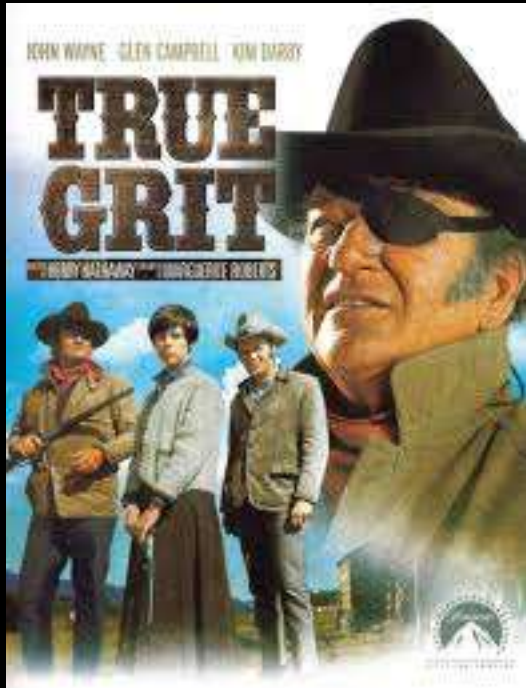

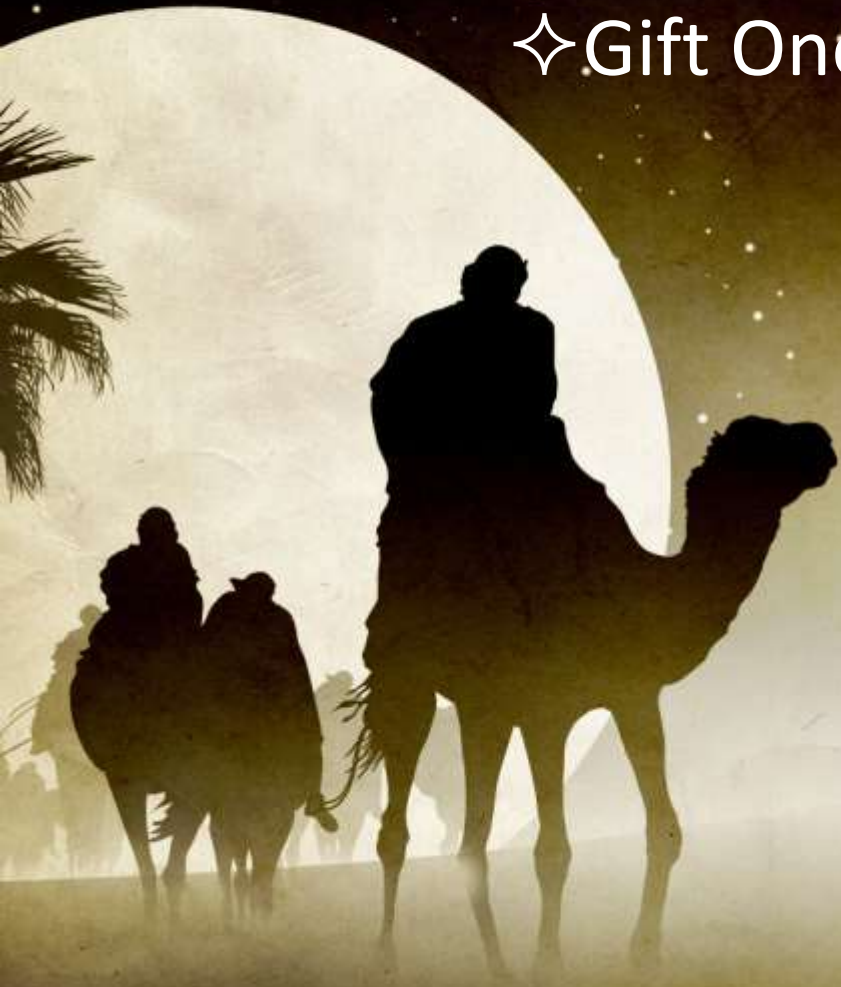

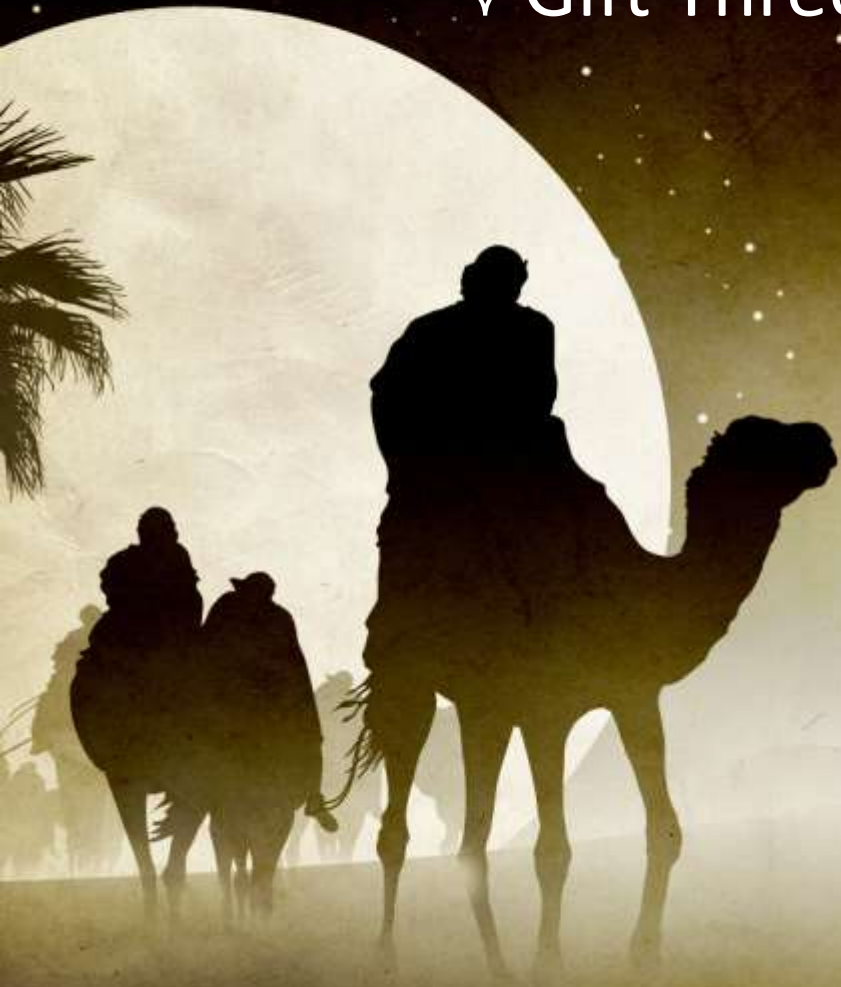
Myrrh is for the Curer
