Psalm 111:10 (NKJV)

¹⁰ The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom; A good understanding have all those who do *His commandments*.

Proverbs 1:7 (NLT)

⁷ Fear of the LORD is the foundation of true knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline.

ISAIAH'S ENCOUNTER WITH GOD

Isaiah 6

It was in the year King Uzziah died^[a] that I saw the Lord. He was sitting on a lofty throne, and the train of his robe filled the Temple. ² Attending him were mighty seraphim, each having six wings. With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew. ³ They were calling out to each other,

“Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of Heaven’s Armies!

The whole earth is filled with his glory!”

⁴ Their voices shook the Temple to its foundations, and the entire building was filled with smoke.

⁵ Then I said, “It’s all over! I am doomed, for I am a sinful man. I have filthy lips, and I live among a people with filthy lips. Yet I have seen the King, the LORD of Heaven’s Armies.”

¹⁷ When I saw Him, I fell at his feet as though dead.

GOD DESCRIBES HIMSELF

Isaiah 44: 6-7 (NLV)

⁶ The Lord, the King of Israel and the One Who saves and frees from sin, the Lord of All, says, “I am the first and I am the last. There is no God besides Me.

⁷ Who is like Me? Let him make it known. Yes, let him tell Me what happened from the time I made people long ago. And let him tell the things that are coming and what is going to happen

1 Peter 2:9 (KJV)

⁹ But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a **peculiar** people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light

Exodus 20:7 (MSG)

⁷ No using the name of GOD, your God, in curses or silly banter; GOD won't put up with the irreverent use of his name.

RESPECT FOR GOD

Psalm 111 (KJV)

Praise ye the LORD. I will praise the LORD with my whole heart, in the assembly of the upright, and in the congregation.

² The works of the LORD are great, sought out of all them that have pleasure therein.

³ His work is honourable and glorious: and his righteousness endureth for ever.

⁴ He hath made his wonderful works to be remembered: the LORD is gracious and full of compassion.

⁵ He hath given meat unto them that fear Him: he will ever be mindful of his covenant.

⁶ He hath shewed his people the power of his works, that He may give them the heritage of the heathen.

⁷ The works of His hands are verity and judgment; all His commandments are sure.

⁸ They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in truth and uprightness.

⁹ He sent redemption unto his people: He hath commanded his covenant for ever: holy and **reverend** is His name.

¹⁰ The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments: His praise endureth for ever.

RESPECT FOR GOD

Matthew 23:9-10 (MSG)

8-10 “Don’t let people do that to *you*, put you on a pedestal like that. You all have a single Teacher, and you are all classmates. Don’t set people up as experts over your life, letting them tell you what to do. Save that authority for God; let *Him* tell you what to do. No one else should carry the title of ‘Father’; you have only one Father, and He’s in heaven. And don’t let people maneuver you into taking charge of them. There is only one Life-Leader for you and them—Christ.

GOD – FEAR NOT

Isaiah 44:8

⁸ Do not fear. Do not be afraid. Have I not made it known to you from long ago? And you have heard Me. Is there a God besides Me? No, there is no other Rock. I know of none.”
